

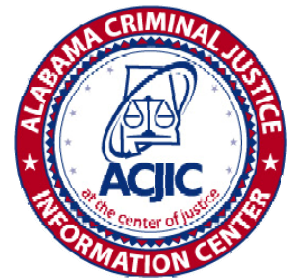

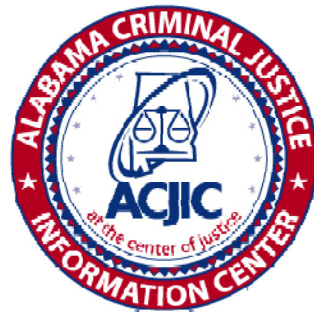

For purposes of this report, domestic violence is indicated when the relationship of the victim and offender is husband, wife, common-law spouse, ex-husband, ex-wife, girlfriend, boy-friend, ex-girlfriend, or ex-boyfriend. Statistics contained within this report include adult and juvenile victims.

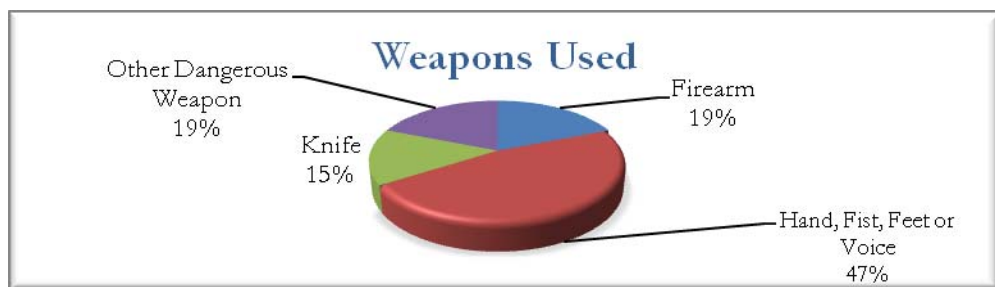

Domestic Violence – 2007

- Of the **19,808** violent offenses* reported in 2007, **10%** were domestic violence incidents. Domestic violence was indicated in **2,012** offenses reported: in **32** homicides; **206** rapes; **99** robberies; and in **1,675** aggravated assaults. **1,050** incidents of domestic violence were cleared for a **52%** clearance rate. **36%** of the clearances were exceptional, i.e. lack of prosecution.
- There were **29,042** domestic simple assaults, which represent **35%** of all simple assaults reported in 2007. **15,725** domestic simple assaults were cleared for a **54%** clearance rate. **44%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- 74%** of the victims were females, and **26%** were males. **51%** of the victims were black, and **49%** were white. In **55%** of the offenses, the offender was black, and in **77%** the offender was male.
- A firearm was the weapon used in **19%** of the offenses; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in **47%**; a knife was the weapon used in **15%**; and other dangerous weapons were used in **19%**.
- 50%** of the victims suffered injuries: **11%** were injured with a firearm; **20%** were injured with a knife; **51%** were injured with fists, hands or feet; and **18%** were injured with other dangerous weapons.
- In **29%** of domestic violence offenses the victim was the wife/ex-wife of the offender; in **46%** the victim was the girlfriend/ex-girlfriend of the offender.

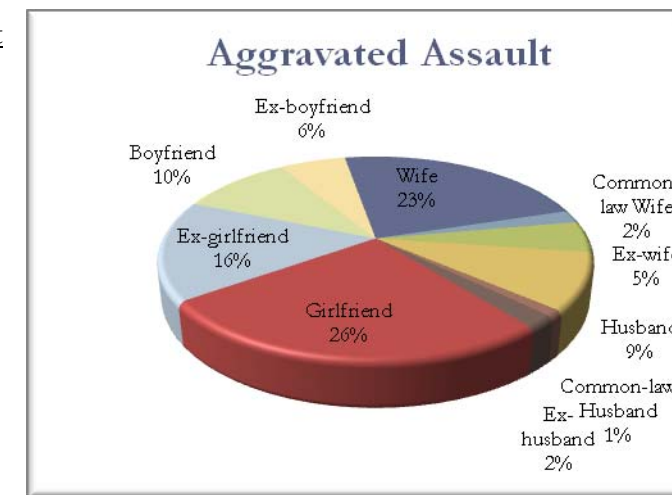

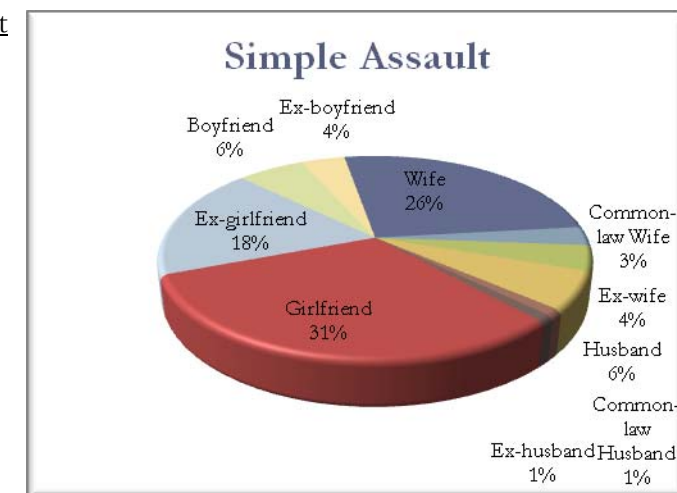

Domestic Violence – Assault

Aggravated

- Of the **11,019** aggravated assaults reported in 2007, **1,675** were domestic aggravated assaults - or **15%** of all aggravated assaults reported in Alabama for that year. **884** incidents of domestic aggravated assault were cleared for a **53%** clearance rate. **33%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- A firearm was the weapon used in **19%** of the assaults; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in **42%**; a knife was the weapon used in **18%**; and other dangerous weapons were used in **21%**.
- **50%** of the victims were injured: **10%** with a firearm; **22%** with a knife; **48%** with hands, fists or feet; and **20%** with other dangerous weapons.
- **30%** of the victims were a wife or ex-wife of the offender; **42%** of the victims were a girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender; and **12%** of the victims were a husband or ex-husband of the offender. **55%** of the offenders were black, and **74%** were males.

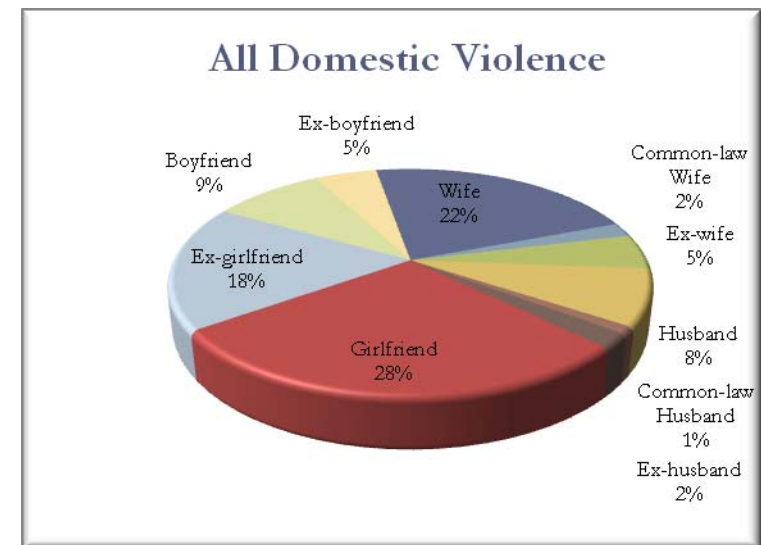
Simple

- There were **29,042** domestic simple assaults reported in 2007, or **35%** of all simple assaults for that year. **15,725** incidents of domestic simple assaults were cleared for a **54%** clearance rate. **44%** of the clearances were exceptional, i.e. lack of prosecution.
- Hands, fists, feet or voice were used as a weapon in **89%** of these assaults, however, **36%** of the victims still reported injuries.
- **33%** of the victims were a wife or ex-wife to the offender; **49%** were a girlfriend or ex-girlfriend.

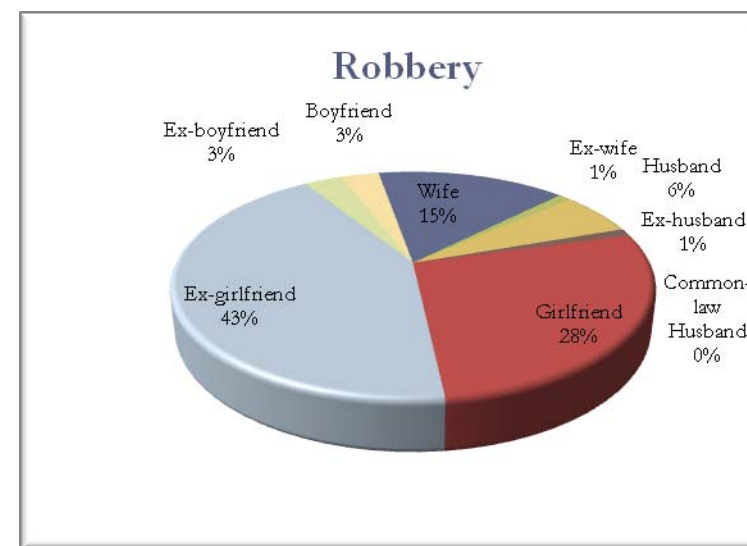
Domestic Violence - Homicide

- There were **32** domestic homicides reported in 2007, representing **8%** of the **391** homicides reported in Alabama for that year. **26** domestic homicides were cleared for a **81%** clearance rate.
- **44%** of the victims were males, and **56%** were females. **47%** of the victims were black, **47%** were white, and **6%** were of another race.
- A firearm was the weapon used in **63%** of the homicides; a knife was the weapon used **22%**; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in **0%**; and other dangerous weapons were used in **15%**.
- In **31%** of the homicides the victim was the wife or ex-wife of the offender; in **18%** the victim was the husband or ex-husband; in **28%** the victim was the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend; and in **22%** of the homicides the victim was the boyfriend or ex-boyfriend of the offender.
- **91%** of the homicides occurred at a residence; **6%** occurred in a street, alley, or parking lot; and **3%** occurred in other locations.
- In **48%** of the homicides the offender was white; and in **58%** the offender was a male. **45%** of the homicides had black victims and black offenders; **42%** had white victims and white offenders; **7%** had white victims and black offenders; and **0%** had black victims and white offenders.

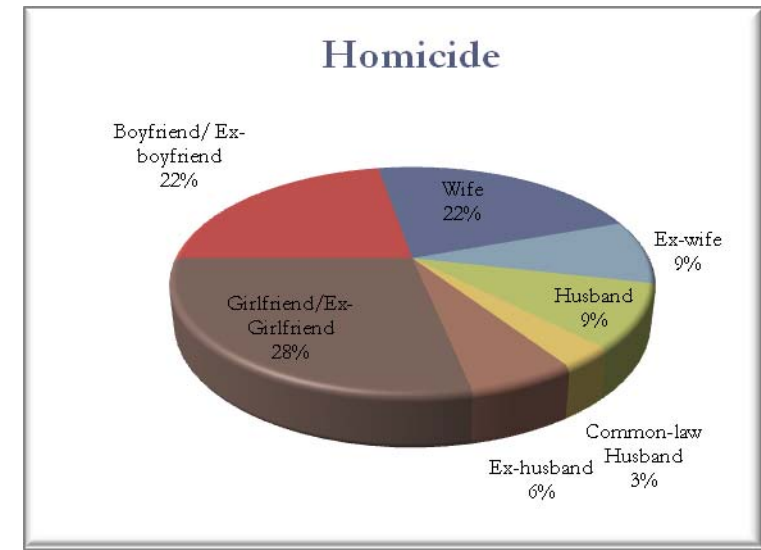
Domestic Violence - Robbery

- There were **99** robberies in 2007 that indicated domestic violence. This represents **1%** of the **6,990** robberies reported for Alabama in that year. **44** domestic robberies were cleared for a **44%** clearance rate. **46%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- A firearm was the weapon used in **34%** of the robberies; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in **56%**; a knife was the weapon used in **3%**; and other dangerous weapons were used in **7%**.
- **44%** of the victims suffered injuries: **10%** were injured with a firearm; **0%** were injured with a knife; **80%** were injured with fists, feet or hands; and **10%** were injured with other dangerous weapons.
- **69%** of the victims were the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender; **22%** of the victims were the wife or ex-wife of the offender.
- **43%** of the offenses occurred at a residence; **22%** occurred in a street or alley; and **35%** occurred in other locations.
- In **73%** of the robberies, the offender was black and in **88%** the offender was a male.

Domestic Violence - Rape

- There were **206** domestic violence rapes in 2007, representing **15%** of the **1,408** rapes reported in Alabama for that year. **96** domestic rapes were cleared for a **47%** clearance rate. **58%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- **47%** of the victims were black females and **53%** were white females.
- A firearm was the weapon used in **3%** of the rapes; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in **93%**; a knife was the weapon used in **1%**; and other dangerous weapons were used in **3%**.
- **43%** of the victims suffered injuries: **4%** were injured with a firearm; **2%** were injured with a knife; **92%** were injured with fists, feet or hands; and **2%** were injured with other dangerous weapons.
- **78%** of the victims were the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender, and **22%** of the victims were the wife or ex-wife of the offender.
- **80%** of the offenses occurred at a residence; **5%** occurred in a street or alley; and **15%** occurred in other locations.
- In **45%** of the rapes the offender was white, and in **55%** the offender was black.
- **39%** of domestic rape victims were juveniles, but only **12%** of the offenders were juveniles.
