

CSA-2010

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's (FMCSA) new national safety initiative for commercial motor vehicles, CSA 2010, is a more efficient and effective method for targeting the safety problems of both motor carriers and their drivers to reduce commercial motor vehicle crashes and fatalities.

This program will not affect the CDL status of the driver, it will create a new profile in the Federal Database of the driver and the carrier based on the new safety measurements.

The CSA 2010 BASICS, an overview:

Ratings will cover these categories:

- Unsafe driving
- Fatigued Driving (Hours-of-Service)
 - Driver Fitness
- Controlled Substances/Alcohol
 - Vehicle Maintenance
 - Cargo-Related
 - Crash Indicator
