Crime in Alabama 006

Crime in Alabama 2006 represents a summary of the nature and extent of the crimes reported by local criminal justice agencies to the Alabama Criminal Justice Information System's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) program. State law mandates that all crimes are reported from state, county and local law enforcement agencies, and the statistics presented in this report are compiled from these reports. Since the UCR program is designed to provide a snapshot of criminal activity in a specific geographical area rather than as a measure of a law enforcement agency's response to crime, it should not be used to evaluate or compare one agency with another. UCR is only one aspect of the activities and responsibilities of the law enforcement community, and the statistics presented herein are not intended to serve as the sole indicator of either the work-load or effectiveness of the reporting agencies.

Since the UCR program is designed to provide a snapshot of criminal activity in a specific geographical area rather than as a measure of a law enforcement agency's response to crime, this report should not be used to evaluate or compare one agency with another. UCR is only one aspect of the activities and responsibilities of the law enforcement community, and the statistics presented herein are not intended to serve as the sole indicator of either the workload or effectiveness of the reporting agencies.

We hope that you find our efforts to continue to provide quality services to Alabama's criminal justice community helpful.

Preface

The 2006 Crime in Alabama report is intended to inform law enforcement officials and private citizens of criminal and law enforcement activity in Alabama. Since the UCR offense and arrest data are the basis of this report, it must be noted that other factors affecting crime are not measured by UCR, such as age, sex, and race of the population, economic conditions of the area, transient population, culture, education, climate, attitudes of the victims toward crime and police, and crime reporting practices of the citizens. Therefore, it is difficult to draw conclusions or make valid comparisons between various jurisdictions by using only the crime and arrest data in this book. The data in this book are used for analyzing crime problems inherent in the criminal justice system and as a foundation for planning and budgeting. Geographic areas covered in this report include the State of Alabama, county and city strata.

We would like to extend our appreciation to law enforcement agencies--sheriff's departments, municipal police departments, and campus police--for their cooperation in the UCR program.

Introduction

In October of 1975, Act 872 passed both houses of the Alabama Legislature creating and establishing the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center (ACJIC) which is commissioned to collect, store, retrieve, analyze, and disseminate criminal justice data. Inherent in ACJIC is a "uniform crime reporting system for the periodic collection and analysis of crimes reported to any and all criminal justice agencies within the state." (Act 872, Section 9, 1975)

With the passage of this bill, mandatory reporting was required of law enforcement agencies in Alabama. Prior to 1976, law enforcement agencies participated in the FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting Program (UCR) on :

proud of the progress made in the incident reporting program. Because of the support and dedication of our law enforcement Alabama is one of the states leading the way for a national IBR system.

Alabama's law enforcement community can be

a voluntary basis. Since mandatory submission, there has been a 185% increase in UCR reporting.

Alabama's UCR program functions in accordance with FBI standards of operation, i.e., a uniform data collection device and quality control procedures which provide viable crime statistics for accurate indication of crime and crime trends.

ACJIC implemented an incident-based reporting system as an alternative to UCR summary reporting in 1977. This Incident-Based Reporting (IBR) System also provides a self-contained internal record keeping system for the agency. IBR is a voluntary system with 99% of Alabama's agencies

participating. This reporting program is more detailed providing greater potential for services, analyses, and resource studies by both the individual agency's crime analysis units and ACJIC.

In 1986, ACJIC organized a 32-person UCR Committee to review the IBR report forms. This committee was made up of law enforcement personnel from small, medium and large police departments and sheriff's departments, computerized agencies, the FBI, and the Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS). The

> committee reviewed and analyzed the ten year old forms and decided that enhancements were needed. The IBR report forms were redesigned with input from Alabama's local agencies.

> Alabama's law enforcement agen-

cies are supplied with monthly reporting forms by ACJIC's Field Advisors who are also made available to the reporting agencies to help answer any questions which may arise regarding forms, crime classifications, and clearance data. The Field Advisors are also responsible for training law enforcement personnel and maintaining the quality of information for output to the criminal justice system.

When the UCR incident reports are returned to ACJIC, they are reviewed for accuracy by the quality control section of UCR. Then the Alabama UCR program furnishes the contributing agencies and the FBI with monthly data for their verification and review process.

Crime and Arrest Data

Valid crime data can provide a solid foundation for statistical analyses, management-oriented analyses and crime breakdowns. These analyses can then aid local police departments in laying out patrol districts, assigning patrol units, and designating community education programs.

Data used in this report are provided by the Uniform Crime Reporting section (UCR) of the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center (ACJIC). ACJIC'S UCR section is the depository for reported offenses and has the responsibility of collecting and disseminating crime data. In 2006, approximately 300 agencies reported known offenses to Alabama's UCR; 99% of Alabama's law enforcement agencies submitted Incident Reports and 1% returned UCR Summaries.

Through a mandate of Congress, Arson is counted as a Part I Offense. So as not to distort crime trends in Total and Property Crime indices, Arson totals will not be included in these sections but will be included in a separate section following property crimes.

Crime data are obtained from the Part I Index of Offenses submitted by law enforcement agencies to Alabama's UCR program. These Part I Offenses are divided into Violent Crime and Property Crimes.

Violent Crimes include Homicide, Rape, Robbery, and Assault.

These crimes are considered violent inasmuch as they are offenses perpetrated against a person(s) with a high risk or injury or death to the victim(s). Property Crimes are comprised of Burglary, Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, and Arson*. Property or Non-Violent Crimes lack the aspect of force and/or bodily harm to the victim(s).

Clearance and arrest data are also reported to Alabama's UCR.

A crime is considered cleared, either by arrest or by exceptional means, when enough evidence is found to charge a suspect and take him/her into custody. It is conceivable that one arrest could clear several offenses or that several arrests could clear one offense. The clearance rate is achieved by taking the number of clearances over the number of crimes reported:



This report is a composite picture of crime and law enforcement activity in Alabama for 2006. It provides a breakdown for the State and localities participating in the UCR program. The report concentrates on the Index Crime of the FBI's Part I Offenses and offers tabular and narrative formats for comparisons, trends, rates, and percent changes.

Arrest a measure of law enforcement activity by which an individual is detained in legal custody.

> willful or malicious burning with or without intent to defraud, includes attempts. (Through a Congressional mandate, 1979 was the first year arson was counted as a Part I offense.) Arson is divided into the following categories:

Structural

Single occupancy residential - houses, townhouses, duplexes, etc.

the UCR system defines adults as 18 years of age and over.

Other residential - apartments, tenements, hotels, motels, dormitories, boarding houses, etc.

Storage - barns, garages, warehouses, etc.

Industrial/manufacturing.

Other commercial - stores, restaurants, offices, etc.

Community/public - churches, jails, schools, colleges, hospitals, etc.

All other structures - outbuildings, monuments, buildings under construction.

Mobile

Motor vehicles - automobiles, trucks, buses, motorcycles, etc.

Other mobile property - trailers, recreational vehicles, airplanes, boats, etc.

Other - crops, timber, fences, signs, etc.

the unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe bodily injury, including attempts. Attempted homicide is listed as an aggravated assault.

Burglary unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or theft.

Central City a city with at least 50,000 residents.

City Strata a breakdown of cities according to population.

> a measure of law enforcement activity which shows that a crime has been solved for crime reporting purposes either by the arrest of a suspect or by exceptional means. Exceptional means provides a solution to a crime when there is enough evidence to place a formal charge against an offender, but some element beyond law enforcement control precludes an actual arrest. It is possible for one arrest to clear more than one offense.

Clearance Rate the clearance rate is achieved by taking the number of clearances over the number of crimes reported.

a measure of criminal activity which shows the number of crimes reported per 100,000 residents.

Criminal Activity measured by reported crimes, trends, rates.

Forcible Entry offenses in which force of any kind is used to unlawfully enter a structure for the purpose of committing a theft or felony.

whenever more than one offense is committed simultaneously, the most severe offense is reported to UCR. The exception is arson which is always reported along with the most serious offense.

the willful killing of another as based on police investigation.

Incident-Based a voluntary crime reporting system developed by ACJIC as **Reporting System** an alternative to the UCR Summary. Juveniles the UCR system defines juveniles as males and females 17 years of age and younger. unlawful taking or stealing of property or articles without the use of force, violence or fraud, i.e., pocket Larcenv picking, purse snatching, shoplifting, theft from coin-operated machines, etc. **Law Enforcement** police activity as measured by clearances and arrests. Activity Minimal injury personal injury involving abrasions, minor lacerations requiring no more than usual first-aid treatment. **Motor Vehicles** automobiles, trucks, buses, motorcycles, etc. **Motor Vehicle Theft** unlawful taking or stealing of a motor vehicle, including attempts. Non-Residence any structure used for purposes other than a residence. Part I Index a category of UCR offenses deemed more serious and/or most frequent. The Part I Index Crimes include homicide, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft, and arson. Crimes Part II Offenses a category of UCR offenses which include: Other Assaults non-aggravated assaults. Forgery and making, altering, uttering, or possessing with intent to defraud, anything false which is made to appear true, includes attempts. Counterfeiting Fraud fraudulent conversion and obtaining money or property by false pretenses. misappropriation or misapplication of money or property entrusted to one's care, custody, or control. **Embezzlement Stolen Property** buving, receiving, and possessing stolen property, includes attempts. **Vandalism** willful or malicious destruction, injury, disfigurement or defacement of property without the consent of the owner or person having custody or control. all violations of regulations or statutes controlling the carrying, using, possessing, furnishing and Weapons manufacturing of deadly weapons or silencers, includes attempts. Prostitution and sex offenses of a commercial nature. **Commercialized Vice** Sex offenses (other than rape, prostitution, and commercialized vice) statutory rape, offenses against chastity, common decency, morals, etc. Narcotic Drug Laws offenses relating to narcotics, i.e., possession, sale, use, growing and manufacturing of narcotic drugs. Gambling promoting, permitting, or engaging in illegal gambling.

Offenses Against non-support, the Family and Children

non-support, neglect, desertion, or abuse of family and children.

Driving Under driving or operating any motor vehicle or common carrier while drunk or under the influence of liquor or narcotics.

Liquor Laws

violations of state or local liquor laws.

Drunkenness

drunkenness or intoxication.

Disorderly Conduct

breach of the peace.

Vagrancy

begging, loitering, etc.

All Other Offenses

all violations of state or local laws, except categories mentioned above, Part I Offenses, and traffic violations. Including, but not limited to bigamy, blackmail, bribery, contempt of court, discrimination, perjury, possession and/or sale of obscene material, quarantine violations, etc.

Property Crimes

(non-violent crimes) index crimes which lack the aspect of force and/or bodily harm to the victim(s). Included in this category are burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft, and arson.

Recovery

finding stolen property. It should be noted that a recovered article does not clear a crime, although the owner is reunited with his property a crime was committed and a suspect must be taken into custody to clear the offense.

Reported Crimes

crimes reported to law enforcement officials.

NOTE: In this report, only those offenses which prove to be actual offenses are used. Those cases which have been deemed unfounded are excluded from the crime totals. (It should be mentioned that a change in reporting on the part of victims can effect an increase or a decrease for certain crimes.)

Residence

any dwelling structure used for human habitation.

Robbery

stealing or taking anything from the care, custody, or control of a person, in his presence, by force or by threat of force, including attempts. Robbery is broken down into seven categories:

- * Highway robberies occurring on the streets, in alleys, outside of structures.
- * Commercial house hotels, motels, lodging houses, loan companies.
- * Gas or service stations sell gasoline and related products.
- * Convenience stores neighborhood stores which specialize in the sale of consumable items.
- * Residence robberies occurring in a dwelling or on the premises.
- * Banking establishments banks, savings & loan institutions, credit unions, etc.
- * Miscellaneous churches, temples, schools, union halls, government buildings, public transit systems, etc.

Serious Injury

personal injury is considered serious if there are broken bones, internal injuries, or if stitches are required.

Uniform Crime Reports standardized reporting forms used by law enforcement officials to report criminal activity within their jurisdiction.

Uniform Crime Reporting System is the depository of the Uniform Crime Reports and Incident Reporting forms and provides for the collection and dissemination of crime data.

Unlawful Entry

involves no force and is achieved by use of an unlocked door or window. The element of trespass is essential.

Urbanized Areas

incorporated or unincorporated places of 2500 or more inhabitants.

Violent Crimes


index crimes which are offenses perpetrated against a person (or persons) with a high risk of injury or death to the victim. Crimes included in this category are homicide, rape, robbery, and assault.

Total Index Crime

Total Index Crime is comprised of the Part I Offenses: Homicide, Rape, Robbery, Assault, Burglary, Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, and Arson.* Both offense and arrest data are collected for Part I crime.

Alabama Crime - 2006 Summary Offense Data

- There were **183,802** crimes reported in 2006, a 3% decrease from 2005.
- The crime rate for the state was **3996.5** per 100,000 inhabitants.
- On a daily average, there were **504** Part I offenses reported.
- The total property value stolen in 2006 was \$221,604,848; 17% was recovered.
- There were **318** Law Enforcement Officers assaulted in 2006. On the average, more than one officer was assaulted per day in 2006. **64**% received serious injuries and **36**% received minimal or no injuries.



Total Crime Trends 2002-2006



Clearance and Arrest Data

- There were 31,704 clearances in 2006, providing a clearance rate of 17%.
- A total of 24,876 persons were arrested for Part I offenses.* Part I arrests made up 13% of all arrests in Alabama in 2006.
- Juveniles made up 14% of the Part I arrests, males made up 73% of persons arrested for Part I offenses, 54% of those arrested for Part I offenses were black and 46% were white.
- A total of 179,666 people were arrested for Part II offenses; 5% of Part II arrests were juveniles. Males made up 75% of Part II arrests. Whites made up 55% and blacks, 45% of Part II arrests.
- A total of 17,365 people were arrested for narcotic drug violations. 7% were for sale and 93% for possession. 93% were adult and 7% juvenile.
- There were 30,457 people arrested for alcohol violations: 45% were arrested for driving under the influence; 21% were arrested for liquor law violations; and 34% for public drunkenness. 97% of the alcohol arrests were adults and 3% were juveniles.



Property Crime

Property Crime is comprised of Burglary, Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, and Arson.* These crimes are designated as non-violent crimes because they lack the aspect of force and/or bodily harm to

the victim(s).

Property Crime Summary 2006

- In 2006 there were **164,810** property crimes reported. This is a 3% decrease from 2005. Property crime makes up **90**% of the total Index offenses.
- The property crime rate was **3583.6** per 100,000 inhabitants. On the average there were **451.5** property crimes reported per day.
- A total of **24,674** property crimes were cleared in 2006 for an **15**% clearance rate.
- In 2006, **18,355** people were arrested for property crimes: **86%** were adults; **50%** were white; and **69%** were males.
- Total property value stolen in 2006 was \$221,604,848; 17% was recovered.

Violent Crime

Violent Crime is comprised of Homicide, Rape, Robbery, and Assault. These crimes are designated as Violent Crimes because they are offenses perpetrated against a person (or persons) with a high risk of injury or death to the victim.

Violent Crime Summary 2006

- There were 18,992 Violent Crimes reported in 2006, a 3% decrease from 2005. Violent crime makes up 10% of the total Index offenses.
- The violent crime rate was 413.0 per 100,000 inhabitants.
- On the average, there were 51.8 violent crimes reported per day.
- There were 7,030 violent crimes cleared in 2006 for a 37% clearance rate.
- In 2006, 6,521 people were arrested for Violent Crimes: 88% were adults; 31% were white; and, 83% were male.



Homicide

Murder and non-negligent manslaughter is the willful (non-negligent) killing of one human being by another. Not included in the count for this offense classification are deaths caused by negligence, suicide, accident, justifiable homicides which are the killings of felons by law enforcement officers in the line of duty or by private citizens; and attempts to murder or assaults to murder, which are scored as aggravated assaults.

- There were **353** homicides in Alabama in 2006 representing a **7%** increase over 2005.
- The homicide rate was **7.7** per 100,000 inhabitants, with an average of **less than 1** homicide per day. **232** homicides were cleared for a **66%** clearance rate.
- There were **374** persons arrested for homicide: **5**% were juveniles; **88**% were males; and **33**% were white.
- The age group with the greatest number of homicide victims was 21-25, comprising **17%** of the homicide victims. **37%** had black victims and black offenders; **18%** had white victims and white offenders, **1%** black victim and white offender, **5%** white victim and black offender, and in **40%**, the race of the offender was unknown.
- Handguns were used in **59**% of all homicides, knives in **8**%, hands, fists or feet in **3**%, and other firearms, such as rifles and shotguns, in **5**%.
- 12% of homicide victims were related to the offender, and 26% were acquainted with the offender. 24% of the victims were killed by strangers and in 38% the relationship was unknown. In 5% of all homicides the victim and offender were boyfriend/girlfriend, and 7% of all homicides were domestic in 2006.
- 21% of the homicides were a result of an argument, 11% of the homicides occurred during the commission of a felony, and in 68% of the homicides the circumstances were unknown.
- 20% of all homicides occurred on a Sunday. 56% occurred at a residence while 25% occurred on a highway, street or in an alley.



Rape is the carnal knowledge of a female through force or the threat of force, includes attempts.*

- 1,472 rapes were reported in Alabama in 2006. This is a 3% decrease from 2005.
- The rape rate was **61.6** per 100,000 females.
- 551 rapes were cleared for a 37% clearance rate.
- On the average, there were 4 rapes reported per day in 2006.
- 347 males were arrested for rape with 11% being juveniles. White males made up 43% of rape arrests. 28.7 is the average age of the rape offender with a range from 11 to 75 years.
- 21.4 is the average age of the rape victim with a range from 2 to 80 years. 55% of the rape victims in Alabama were white females; 41% were black females, and 4% were other or unknown. 27% of all rape victims were 13, 14, and 15-year-olds.
- In **70**% of the rapes, the victim and offender knew or were related to each other; in **8**% the victim and offender were strangers; and in **22**% the relationship was unknown.
- 36% of the rapes involved a white victim and white offender; 12% a white victim and black offender; 34% a black victim and black offender; 1% a black victim and white offender. In 17% the race of the offender was unknown or other.
- In **80**% of the rapes, hand, fists and/or verbal threats were used to exert force upon a victim; guns were used in **5**%, and knives in **3**% of the rapes.
- 30% of the rapes occurred in the victim's residence; 17% in the offender's residence; 3% in the offender's vehicle; and 5% at the residence of a friend or relative of the victim. 17% of rapes occurred on a Saturday or on a Sunday.
- 77% of victims reported no other injuries from the rape and 52% submitted to a medical exam.

Robbery

Robbery is the stealing or taking anything of value from the care, custody, or control of a person, in his presence, by force or by threat of force, includes attempts.

- There were 6,564 robberies reported in 2006, an 7% increase over 2005
- The robbery rate was **142.7** per 100,000 inhabitants. On the average, there were **18.0** robberies reported per day in 2006.
- There were **2,009** robberies cleared for a **31%** clearance rate.
- 1,835 persons were arrested for robbery: **19**% were juveniles; **20**% were white; and **90**% were males.
- In **51**% of the robberies a firearm was used; **24**% were strong arm; in **5**% a knife or cutting instrument was used; and in **20**% other dangerous weapons were used. In **84**% of the robberies the victim was not injured.
- 17% occurred on a Saturday, and 15% on a Friday. 19% occurred on a highway, street or in an alley; 24% at a residence; 14% in a parking lot; 11% at a convenience store; 13% at another commercial establishment; 3% at a service station; 2% at a bank; and 14% on all other premises.



Assault

Assault is the unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe bodily injury, includes attempts.

- There were **10,603** aggravated assaults reported in 2006 for an 8% decrease from 2005.
- There were **230.5** assaults per 100,000 inhabitants. On the average, there were **29.1** assaults reported per day. **4,238** assaults were cleared for a **40%** clearance rate.
- 3,965 people were arrested for aggravated assaults in 2006: 9% were juvenile, 78% were male and 36% were white.
- 32% of the assaults were a result of firearms; 22% other dangerous weapons; 14% knives; and, 32% hands and fists. 47% of the victims were injured.
- In **39**% of the assaults the victim was a friend or acquaintance of the offender; in **21**% the victim and offender were family; **5**% were strangers; 9% were boyfriend/girlfriend; and in **26**% the relationship was unknown.
- 61% occurred at a residence and 18% occurred on a street, highway, or alley. 5% occurred in a parking lot, 5% at a commercial establishment, and 3% occurred at a school. 18% occurred on a Saturday, or on a Sunday and 14% on a Friday.

Burglary

Burglary is the unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or a theft. Includes forcible entry, unlawful entry and attempted forcible entry.

- There were **40,866** burglaries reported in 2006, a **1**% decrease from 2005.
- There were **888.6** burglaries per 100,000 inhabitants. On the average, there were **112.0** burglaries reported per day.
- 4,270 burglaries were cleared for an 11% clearance rate.
- 3,573 persons were arrested for burglary: 20% juveniles; 91% males; and 54% white.
- 72% of the burglaries were forcible entry, 26% were unlawful entries, and 2% were attempted forcible entry. In 57% of burglaries the point of entry was a door; in 21% a window; and in 22% the point of entry was other.
- There were 25,412 residential burglaries with 39% being at night, and 61% during the day. There were 15,454 non-residential burglaries with 53% being at night, and 47% during the day. 16% of all burglaries occurred on a Friday while 15% occurred on a Monday or a Wednesday.

Larceny is the unlawful taking or stealing of property or articles without the use of force, violence and fraud.


- 110,678 larcenies were reported in 2006 for a 4% decrease from 2005.
- The larceny rate was 2406.6 per 100,000 inhabitants.
- 17,769 larcenies were cleared for a 16% clearance rate. On the average, there were 303.2 larcenies reported per day.
- There were **13,630** persons arrested for larceny in 2006: **13%** were juveniles; **63%** were males, and **52%** were white.
- 22% of the larcenies were thefts of items from motor vehicles; 10% were shoplifting, and 13% were theft of items from buildings.
- The value of total property stolen in larcenies was \$86,983,095, or an average of \$786 per incident.

Motor Vehicle Theft

Motor Vehicle Theft is the unlawful taking or stealing of a motor vehicle, includes attempts.

- There were 13,266 motor vehicle thefts reported in 2006 for a 6% increase over 2005.
- The motor vehicle theft rate for Alabama in 2006 was 288.5 thefts for every 100,000 inhabitants. On the average, there were 36.3 motor vehicles stolen per day.
- A total of 2,635 motor vehicle thefts were cleared for a clearance rate of 20%.
- A total of 1,152 people were arrested in 2006 for motor vehicle theft: 11% were juveniles; 78% were males; and, 50% were white. 46% of the juveniles arrested were below the legal driving age of 16.
- The dollar value resulting from locally stolen motor vehicles was \$84,889,724. The value recovered was \$29,469,002 or 35%.
- 17% of motor vehicle thefts occurred on a Friday and 16% on a Saturday; 53% occurred at a residence.

Arson is the willful or malicious burning with or without intent to defraud, includes attempts. It should be noted that the hierarchy rule does not apply to arson, meaning that any offense(s) committed in conjunction with arson results in the most serious offense, as well as the arson incident, being reported to UCR.

- A total of **347** arsons were reported in 2006. This represents a **17**% increase over 2005. **71**% were structural arsons, **28**% were motor vehicles and other mobile property, and **1**% were other.
- There were 40 arsons cleared in 2006 for a 12% clearance rate.
- On the average, there was **1** arson reported per day.
- There were 110 people arrested for arson: 29% were juveniles; 69% were males; and 47% were white.
- In 19% of the structural arsons, the building was uninhabited or not normally in use.
- The total value of property damaged or destroyed by arson amounted to \$5,622,108. Structural arsons amounted to \$4,420,408 for an average of \$18,042 per incident. Arson of mobile property amounted to \$1,199,700 in damages for an average of \$12,118 per incident. Arson of other property caused \$2,000 in damages for an average of \$667 per incident.

Part II Arrest Data

Part II Offenses include crimes other than those defined as Part I Offenses. The nature of many Part II Offenses is such that they go undetected until an arrest is made; therefore, for UCR purposes, only arrest data is collected.

- A total of **179,666** persons were arrested in Alabama in 2006 for Part II offenses (includes arson arrests).
- This is a decrease of 1% from 2005's figure of 181,930.
- 55% of Part II arrestees were white and 45% were black.
- 95% of the Part II arrests were adults.
- Males made up 75% of Part II arrests.
- Liquor violations (DUI, drunkenness, liquor laws violations) made up **17**% of the Part II arrests. Narcotics violations made up **10**% of the Part II arrests.

Liquor Violations

- There were **30,457** people arrested for alcohol violations in 2006.
- 13,566 people were arrested for DUI with 99% being 18 and over. **81%** of the DUI arrests were males, 79% of DUI arrests were white.
- There were **6,441** people arrested for liquor laws violations (bootlegging, buying or selling to minors, etc.) **12%** were juveniles, **78%** were males and **82%** were white.
- There were **10,450** people arrested in 2006 for public drunkenness. **1%** were juveniles, **83%** were males and **76%** were white.

Drug Abuse Violations

Drug abuse violations involve the illegal sale, possession, manufacture, use, cultivation, etc. of narcotic and non-narcotic drugs.

Illegal drugs are divided into four categories:

- 1. Opium or cocaine and their derivatives such as morphine, heroin, codeine, and "crack".
- 2. Marijuana.
- 3. Synthetic narcotics which are manufactured narcotics which cause true drug addiction such as demerol and methadone.
- 4. Dangerous non-narcotic drugs which include barbiturates, amphetamines and methamphetamine.
 - There were **17,365** persons arrested for drug violations, **7**% were for sale of drugs and **93**% were for possession.
 - 7% of the drug arrests were juveniles, 83% were males and 43% were white.
 - Marijuana possession resulted in the greatest number of arrests for drug violations, 9,339 for 54% of the drug arrests. Possession of cocaine resulted in 5,014 arrests, or 29% of all drug arrests.



Considering only sworn employees, this provides a ratio of 2.3 officers per 1,000 population in Alabama. The national average approximates 2 officers per 1,000 population.

Officers Killed or Assaulted

Killed

In 2006, two full-time, sworn law enforcement officers were killed by felonious act in the line of duty in Alabama. Two officers died in accidents while on duty.

April 7, 2006	A corporal with the Saraland Police Department died of a heart attack during physical training while on duty.
August 16, 2006	A sergeant with the Autauga County Sheriff's Office died in a traffic accident while on duty.
September 30, 2006	A Montgomery Police Department officer was shot and killed while making a traffic stop.
October 23, 2006	An officer with the Fairfield Police Department was shot and killed while making a traffic stop.

Assaulted

In 2006 there were **318** law enforcement officers assaulted in the line of duty. **202** officers, or **64%**, received serious injuries. The remainder received minimal or no injuries.

Hands, fists or feet were used in 201 assaults or 63% of the incidents. Firearms were used in 86 cases or 27%.

Responding to a disturbance call was the most dangerous police activity, resulting in **23**% of the assaults. The next most dangerous activity was traffic, resulting in **20**% of the assaults.

48% of the assaults on police officers were cleared.

This report does not try to account for factors which contribute to the number and type of crime in a particular area, i.e., age, sex, race of population, transients, climate, employment, etc. Any effort to make crime comparisons between one area and another should be limited in scope and acknowledge the existence of these various factors impacting the incidence of crime.

A clearance is a measure of law enforcement activity whereby enough evidence is found to charge a suspect and take him into custody (an arrest) or when a crime is solved but no formal charges are brought against a suspect (clearance by exceptional means). The clearance rate is achieved by taking the number of offenses and dividing that number into the number of clearances.

It is important to note that clearance data is reported on a monthly basis to UCR and, therefore, it is possible for an arrest made in one month to clear a crime committed in previous months or years.

Alabama is comprised of sixty-seven (67) counties, each averaging 756.8 square miles.

Incorporated and unincorporated areas not having a municipal police department are protected by the county sheriff and are included in his jurisdiction. Since UCR data deals with criminal activity in a particular geographic rather than with law enforcement agencies' activities, we do not intend, nor recommend, that this data be used to evaluate or compare one agency with another.

Due to diverse demographic characteristics, the county data will be presented in alphabetical order rather than by population strata. It will include reported crime and clearance data submitted by Alabama's 67 county sheriffs. County data does not include crime data submitted by municipal police departments contained within the county boundaries. The numbers in parentheses on the following pages denote the number of months the agency reported to UCR if it was less than twelve.

A clearance is a measure of law enforcement activity whereby enough evidence is found to charge a suspect and take him into custody (an arrest) or when a crime is solved but no formal charges are brought against a suspect (clearance by exceptional means). The clearance rate is achieved by taking the number of offenses and dividing that number into the number of clearances.

It is important to note that clearance data is reported on a monthly basis to UCR and, therefore, it is possible for an arrest made in one month to clear a crime committed in previous months or years.
