Juvenile Victims of Violent Crime

Data presented in this report was provided by the Uniform Crime Reporting Division of ACJIC for the calendar year of 2000. For purposes of this report a juvenile is defined as a person 17 years of age or younger.

Juvenile Victims of Violent Crime

- In the <u>22,084</u> violent offenses* reported in 2000, <u>12%</u> of the victims were juveniles. There were <u>2,566</u> juvenile victims: <u>15</u> juvenile homicide victims; <u>592</u> juvenile rape victims; <u>260</u> juvenile robbery victims; and <u>1,699</u> juvenile victims of aggravated assault.
- There were <u>8,654</u> juvenile victims of simple assault, which represent <u>12%</u> of all victims of simple assaults reported in 2000.
- <u>48%</u> of the victims were males, and <u>52%</u> were females. <u>52%</u> of the victims were black, and <u>48%</u> were white.
- A firearm was the weapon used in <u>5%</u> of the offenses; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in <u>77%</u>; a knife was the weapon used in <u>3%</u>; and other dangerous weapons were used in <u>15%</u>.
- <u>38%</u> of the victims suffered injuries: <u>3%</u> were injured with a firearm; <u>4%</u> were injured with a knife; <u>78%</u> were injured with fists, feet or hands; and <u>15%</u> were injured with other dangerous weapons.
- <u>76%</u> of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; <u>5%</u> of the offenders were strangers; and in <u>19%</u> of the offenses the offender was unknown. In <u>32%</u> of the offenses, the offender was also a juvenile.
- <u>51%</u> of the offenses occurred at a residence; <u>18%</u> occurred in a street or alley; <u>12%</u> occurred at a school; <u>5%</u> occurred in a parking lot; and <u>14%</u> occurred in other locations.

Juvenile Victims of Homicide

- There were <u>15</u> juvenile homicide victims in 2000, representing <u>5%</u> of the victims of the <u>314</u> homicides reported in Alabama for that year. Three juveniles died as a result of child abuse, and <u>2</u> juveniles were killed by another juveniles.
- <u>80%</u> of the victims were males, and <u>20%</u> were females. <u>67%</u> of the victims were black, and <u>33%</u> were white.
- A firearm was the weapon used in <u>40%</u> of the homicides; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in <u>26%</u>; a knife was the weapon used in <u>10%</u>; and other dangerous weapons were used in <u>24%</u>.
- In 23% of the homicides the victim was related to or acquainted with the offender; in 31% the victim and offender were strangers; and in 46% the offender was unknown.
- <u>62%</u> of the homicides occurred at a residence; <u>15%</u> occurred in a street or alley; and <u>23%</u> occurred in other locations.
- In 13% of the homicides the offender was also a juvenile.

Juvenile Victims of Rape

- There were <u>592</u> juvenile female rape victims in 2000, representing <u>43%</u> of the <u>1,377</u> rapes reported in Alabama for that year. <u>63</u> juvenile victims were 10 years of age or younger. <u>51%</u> of the victims were black females and <u>49%</u> were white females.
- A firearm was the weapon used in $\frac{3\%}{1\%}$ of the rapes; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in $\frac{79\%}{3}$; a knife was the weapon used in $\frac{1\%}{3}$; and other dangerous weapons were used in $\frac{17\%}{3}$.
- <u>30%</u> of the victims suffered injuries: <u>2%</u> were injured with a firearm; <u>3%</u> were injured with a knife; <u>83%</u> were injured with fists, feet or hands; and <u>12%</u> were injured with other dangerous weapons.
- $\underline{75\%}$ of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; $\underline{5\%}$ of the offenders were strangers; and in $\underline{20\%}$ of the rapes the offender was unknown.
- <u>70%</u> of the offenses occurred at a residence; <u>3%</u> occurred in a street or alley; <u>2%</u> occurred at a school; and <u>25%</u> occurred in other locations.
- In 20% of the rapes the offender was also a juvenile.

Juvenile Victims of Robbery

- There were <u>5,271</u> robberies reported in 2000, and <u>260</u> juveniles were robbery victims, representing <u>5%</u> of all robbery victims in Alabama for that year. <u>56%</u> of the victims were black and <u>44%</u> were white; <u>88%</u> were males, and <u>12%</u> were females.
- A firearm was the weapon used in <u>40%</u> of the robberies; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in <u>44%</u>; a knife was the weapon used in <u>6%</u>; and other dangerous weapons were used in <u>10%</u>.
- <u>22%</u> of the victims suffered injuries: <u>14%</u> were injured with a firearm; <u>10%</u> were injured with a knife; <u>67%</u> were injured with fists, feet or hands; and <u>9%</u> were injured with other dangerous weapons.
- <u>28%</u> of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; <u>23%</u> of the offenders were strangers; and in <u>49%</u> of the offenses the offender was unknown.
- <u>15%</u> of the offenses occurred at a residence; <u>38%</u> occurred in a street or alley; <u>5%</u> occurred at a school; <u>11%</u> occurred in a parking lot; <u>5%</u> occurred at a store; and <u>26%</u> occurred in other locations.
- In $\underline{82\%}$ of the robberies, the offender was also a juvenile.

Juvenile Victims of Assault

Aggravated

- There were <u>1,699</u> juvenile assault victims in 2000, representing <u>11%</u> of all victims of the <u>15,122</u> aggravated assaults reported in Alabama for that year. <u>56%</u> of the victims were males, and <u>44%</u> were females. <u>60%</u> of the victims were black, and <u>40%</u> were white.
- A firearm was the weapon used in <u>17%</u> of the assaults; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in <u>37%</u>; a knife was the weapon used in <u>12%</u>; and other dangerous weapons were used in <u>34%</u>.
- <u>51%</u> of the victims were injured: <u>11%</u> with a firearm; <u>15%</u> with a knife; <u>37%</u> with fists, feet or hands; and <u>37%</u> with other dangerous weapons
- $\underline{74\%}$ of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; $\underline{8\%}$ of the offenders were strangers; and in $\underline{18\%}$ of the assaults the offender was unknown. In $\underline{33\%}$ of the assaults the offender was also a juvenile.
- <u>55%</u> of the assaults occurred at a residence; <u>20%</u> occurred in a street or alley; <u>7%</u> occurred at a school; and <u>18%</u> occurred in other locations.

Simple

- There were <u>8,654</u> juvenile victims of simple assault in 2000, or <u>12%</u> of all victims of simple assaults for that year. <u>52%</u> of the victims were females and <u>48%</u> were males; <u>51%</u> were black and <u>49%</u> were white.
- $\underline{79\%}$ of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; $\underline{4\%}$ were strangers; and in $\underline{17\%}$ of the offenses the offender was unknown.
