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Juvenile Victims of Violent Crime

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Juvenile Victims of Violent Crime 2003

In the $\underline{18,602}$ violent offenses* reported in 2003, $\underline{13\%}$ of the victims were juveniles. There were $\underline{2,390}$ juvenile victims: $\underline{14}$ juvenile homicide victims; $\underline{704}$ juvenile rape victims; $\underline{273}$ juvenile robbery victims; and $\underline{1,399}$ juvenile victims of aggravated assault.

There were <u>9,442</u> juvenile victims of simple assault, which represent <u>12%</u> of all victims of simple assaults reported in 2003.

46% of the victims were males, and 54% were females. 56% of the victims were black, and 44% were white.

A firearm was the weapon used in $\underline{19\%}$ of the offenses; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in $\underline{54\%}$; a knife was the weapon used in $\underline{6\%}$; and other dangerous weapons were used in $\underline{21\%}$.

 $\underline{37\%}$ of the victims suffered injuries: $\underline{12\%}$ were injured with a firearm; $\underline{9\%}$ were injured with a knife; $\underline{52\%}$ were injured with fists, feet or hands; and $\underline{27\%}$ were injured with other dangerous weapons.

 $\underline{67\%}$ of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; $\underline{10\%}$ of the offenders were strangers; and in $\underline{23\%}$ of the offenses the offender was unknown. In $\underline{29\%}$ of the offenses, the offender was also a juvenile.

<u>53%</u> of the offenses occurred at a residence; <u>18%</u> occurred in a street or alley; <u>6%</u> occurred at a school; <u>5%</u> occurred in a parking lot; and <u>18%</u> occurred in other locations.

Juvenile Victims of Assault 2003

Aggravated

There were $\underline{1,399}$ juvenile assault victims in 2003, representing $\underline{13\%}$ of all victims of the $\underline{10,966}$ aggravated assaults reported in Alabama for that year. $\underline{62\%}$ of the victims were males, and $\underline{38\%}$ were females. $\underline{61\%}$ of the victims were black, and $\underline{39\%}$ were white.

A firearm was the weapon used in $\underline{20\%}$ of the assaults; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in $\underline{44\%}$; a knife was the weapon used in $\underline{10\%}$; and other dangerous weapons were used in $\underline{26\%}$.

46% of the victims were injured: 14% with a firearm; 11% with a knife; 41% with fists, feet or hands; and 34% with other dangerous weapons

 $\underline{74\%}$ of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; $\underline{9\%}$ of the offenders were strangers; and in $\underline{17\%}$ of the assaults the offender was unknown. In $\underline{36\%}$ of the assaults the offender was also a juvenile.

<u>52%</u> of the assaults occurred at a residence; <u>20%</u> occurred in a street or alley; <u>9%</u> occurred at a school; and <u>19%</u> occurred in other locations.

Simple

There were 9,442 juvenile victims of simple assault in 2003, or 12% of all victims of simple assaults for that year. 51% of the victims were females and 49% were males; 53% were black and 47% were white.

<u>79%</u> of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; <u>5%</u> were strangers; and in <u>16%</u> of the offenses the offender was unknown.

Juvenile Victims of Homicide 2003

There were $\underline{14}$ juvenile homicide victims in 2003, representing $\underline{5\%}$ of the victims of the $\underline{297}$ homicides reported in Alabama for that year. Four juveniles died as a result of child abuse, and $\underline{4}$ juveniles were killed by another juvenile.

<u>64%</u> of the victims were males, and <u>36%</u> were females. <u>79%</u> of the victims were black, and 21% were white.

A firearm was the weapon used in $\underline{43\%}$ of the homicides; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in $\underline{36\%}$; a knife was the weapon used in $\underline{14\%}$; and other dangerous weapons were used in $\underline{7\%}$.

In $\underline{43\%}$ of the homicides the victim was related to or acquainted with the offender; in $\underline{14\%}$ the victim and offender were strangers; and in $\underline{43\%}$ the offender was unknown.

<u>71%</u> of the homicides occurred at a residence; <u>14%</u> occurred in a street or alley; and <u>15%</u> occurred in other locations.

In <u>29%</u> of the homicides the offender was also a juvenile.

Juvenile Victims of Robbery 2003

There were $\underline{5,778}$ robberies reported in 2003, and $\underline{273}$ juveniles were robbery victims, representing $\underline{5\%}$ of all robbery victims in Alabama for that year. $\underline{50\%}$ of the victims were black and $\underline{50\%}$ were white; $\underline{85\%}$ were males, and $\underline{15\%}$ were females.

A firearm was the weapon used in $\underline{52\%}$ of the robberies; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in $\underline{37\%}$; a knife was the weapon used in $\underline{3\%}$; and other dangerous weapons were used in $\underline{8\%}$.

 $\underline{16\%}$ of the victims suffered injuries: $\underline{16\%}$ were injured with a firearm; $\underline{0\%}$ were injured with a knife; $\underline{74\%}$ were injured with fists, feet or hands; and $\underline{10\%}$ were injured with other dangerous weapons.

30% of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; 25% of the offenders were strangers; and in 45% of the offenses the offender was unknown.

 $\underline{14\%}$ of the offenses occurred at a residence; $\underline{43\%}$ occurred in a street or alley; $\underline{4\%}$ occurred at a school; $\underline{11\%}$ occurred in a parking lot; $\underline{4\%}$ occurred at a store; and 24% occurred in other locations.

In <u>26%</u> of the robberies, the offender was also a juvenile.

Juvenile Victims of Rape 2003

There were <u>704</u> juvenile female rape victims in 2003, representing <u>45%</u> of the <u>1,561</u> rapes reported in Alabama for that year. <u>49</u> juvenile victims were 10 years of age or younger. <u>53%</u> of the victims were black females and <u>47%</u> were white females.

A firearm was the weapon used in $\underline{2\%}$ of the rapes; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in $\underline{81\%}$; a knife was the weapon used in $\underline{1\%}$; and unknown weapons were used in $\underline{16\%}$.

 $\underline{26\%}$ of the victims suffered injuries: $\underline{1\%}$ were injured with a firearm; $\underline{2\%}$ were injured with a knife; $\underline{91\%}$ were injured with fists, feet or hands; and $\underline{6\%}$ were injured with other dangerous weapons.

<u>72%</u> of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; <u>6%</u> of the offenders were strangers; and in <u>22%</u> of the rapes the offender was unknown.

 $\underline{70\%}$ of the offenses occurred at a residence; $\underline{4\%}$ occurred in a street or alley; $\underline{1\%}$ occurred at a school; and $\underline{25\%}$ occurred in other locations.

In 16% of the rapes the offender was also a juvenile.
