

# **Juvenile Victims of Violent Crime**


- Of the **20,290** violent offenses\* reported in 2011, **10%** of the victims were juveniles. There were **1,945** juvenile victims: **11** juvenile homicide victims; **432** juvenile rape victims; **151** juvenile robbery victims; and **1,351** juvenile victims of aggravated assault.
- There were **6,057** juvenile victims of simple assault, representing **10%** of all victims of simple assaults reported in 2011.
- 42% of the victims were males, and 58% were females. 41% of the victims were black, and 58% were white.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 13% of the offenses; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in 65%; a knife was the weapon used in 7%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 15%.
- 80% of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; 3% of the offenders were strangers; and in 17% of the offenses the offender was unknown.
- 61% of the offenses occurred at a residence; 13% occurred in a street or alley; 8% occurred at a school; 4% occurred in a parking lot; and 14% occurred in other locations.

#### **Juvenile Victims of Assault**

#### Aggravated


- There were **1,351** juvenile assault victims in 2011, representing **10%** of all victims of the **13,690** aggravated assaults reported in Alabama for that year. **49%** of the victims were males, and **51%** were females. **42%** of the victims were black, and **58%** were white.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 13% of the assaults; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in 61%; a knife was the weapon used in 8%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 18%.
- 82% of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; 2% of the offenders were strangers; and in 16% of the assaults the offender was unknown.
- 60% of the assaults occurred at a residence; 13% occurred in a street or alley; 10% occurred at a school; and 17% occurred in other locations.

#### Simple

- There were 6,057 juvenile victims of simple assault in 2011, or 10% of all victims of simple assaults for that year. 52% of the victims were females and 48% were males; 43% were black and 57% were white.
- 87% of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; 1% were strangers; and in 12% of the offenses the offender was unknown.
  - By definition, a simple assault is an assault which did not involve the use of a firearm, knife, cutting instrument or other dangerous weapon and in which the victim did not sustain serious or aggravated injuries.




#### Juvenile Victims of Homicide

- There were 11 juvenile homicide victims in 2011, representing 4% of the victims of the 311 homicides reported in Alabama for that year.
- 82% of the victims were males, and 18% were females. 82% of the victims were black, and 18% were white.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 64% of the homicides; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in 9%; a knife was the weapon used in 9%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 18%.
- In 54% of the homicides the victim was related to or acquainted with the offender; in 0% the victim and offender were strangers; and in 46% the offender was unknown.
- 73% of the homicides occurred at a residence; 18% occurred in a street or alley; and 9% occurred in other locations.




# **Juvenile Victims of Robbery**

- There were **4,885** robberies reported in 2011, and **151** juveniles were robbery victims, representing **3%** of all robbery victims in Alabama for that year.
- 55% of the victims were black and 45% were white; 76% were males, and 24% were females.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 44% of the robberies; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in 48%; a knife was the weapon used in 5%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 3%.
- 34% of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; 13% of the offenders were strangers; and in 53% of the offenses the offender was unknown.
- 18% of the offenses occurred at a residence; 31% occurred in a street or alley; 11% occurred at a school; 14% occurred in a parking lot; 10% occurred at a store; and 16% occurred in other locations.




# Juvenile Victims of Rape

- There were **432** juvenile female rape victims in 2011, representing **31%** of the **1,404** rapes reported in Alabama for that year.
- 35 juvenile victims were 10 years of age or younger. 34% of the victims were black females and 66% were white females.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 1% of the rapes; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in 84%; a knife was the weapon used in 2%; and unknown weapons were used in 13%.
- 88% of the victims were acquainted with or related to the offender; 2% of the offenders were strangers; and in 10% of the rapes the offender was unknown.
- 78% of the offenses occurred at a residence; 5% occurred in a street or alley; 2% occurred at a school; and 15% occurred in other locations.
