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Domestic Violence

This report was produced by the Statistical Analysis Center of the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center. Data presented in this report was provided by the Uniform Crime Reporting Division of ACJIC for the calendar year of 2004. For purposes of this report, domestic violence is indicated when the relationship of the victim and offender is husband, wife, common-law spouse, ex-husband, ex-wife, girlfriend, boy-friend, ex-girlfriend, or ex-boyfriend. Statistics contained within this report include adult and juvenile victims.

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Domestic Violence 2004

Of the <u>19,101</u> violent offenses* reported in 2004, <u>13%</u> were domestic violence incidents. Domestic violence was indicated in <u>2,398</u> offenses reported: in <u>33</u> homicides; <u>246</u> rapes; <u>150</u> robberies; and in <u>1,969</u> aggravated assaults. <u>1,284</u> incidents of domestic violence were cleared for a <u>54%</u> clearance rate. <u>39%</u> of the clearances were exceptional, i.e...lack of prosecution.

There were 26,599 domestic simple assaults, which represent 34% of all simple assaults reported in 2004. 15,541 domestic simple assaults were cleared for a 58% clearance rate. 43% of the clearances were exceptional.

 $\underline{75\%}$ of the victims were females, and $\underline{25\%}$ were males. $\underline{57\%}$ of the victims were black, and $\underline{43\%}$ were white. In <u>61%</u> of the offender was black, and in <u>79%</u> the offender was male.

A firearm was the weapon used in 17% of the offenses; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in 54%; a knife was the weapon used in 14%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 15%.

50% of the victims suffered injuries: 7% were injured with a firearm; 20% were injured with a knife; 54% were injured with fists, feet or hands; and 19% were injured with other dangerous weapons.

In <u>32%</u> of domestic violence offenses the victim was the wife/ex-wife of the offender; in <u>45%</u> the victim was the girlfriend/ex-girlfriend of the offender.

Domestic Violence - Assault 2004

Aggravated

Of the <u>11,335</u> aggravated assaults reported in 2004, <u>1,969</u> were domestic aggravated assaults - or <u>17%</u> of all aggravated assaults reported in Alabama for that year. <u>1,038</u> incidents of domestic aggravated assault were cleared for a <u>53%</u> clearance rate. <u>37%</u> of the clearances were exceptional.

A firearm was the weapon used in 17% of the assaults; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in 51%; a knife was the weapon used in 15%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 17%.

51% of the victims were injured: 5% with a firearm; 21% with a knife; 53% with fists, feet or hands; and 21% with other dangerous weapons

<u>33%</u> of the victims were a wife or ex-wife of the offender; <u>41%</u> of the victims were a girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender; and <u>11%</u> of the victims were a husband or ex-husband of the offender. <u>62%</u> of the offenders were black, and <u>76%</u> were males.

<u>Simple</u>

There were 26,599 domestic simple assaults reported in 2004, or 34% of all simple assaults for that year. <u>15,541</u> incidents of domestic simple assaults were cleared for a <u>58%</u> clearance rate. <u>43%</u> of the clearances were exceptional, i.e...lack of prosecution.

Hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in $\underline{90\%}$ of these assaults, however, $\underline{36\%}$ of the victims still reported injuries.

<u>38%</u> of the victims were a wife or ex-wife to the offender; <u>45%</u> were a girlfriend or ex-girlfriend.

Domestic Violence

Domestic Violence - Homicide 2004

There were <u>33</u> domestic homicides reported in 2004, representing <u>12%</u> of the <u>282</u> homicides reported in Alabama for that year. <u>24</u> domestic homicides were cleared for an <u>73%</u> clearance rate.

45% of the victims were males, and 55% were females. 67% of the victims were black, and 33% were white.

A firearm was the weapon used in 45% of the homicides; a knife was the weapon used 30%; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in 12%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 13%.

In <u>28%</u> of the homicides the victim was the wife or ex-wife of the offender; in <u>24%</u> the victim was the husband; in <u>30%</u> the victim was the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend; and in <u>18%</u> of the homicides the victim was the boyfriend or ex-boyfriend of the offender.

<u>79%</u> of the homicides occurred at a residence; <u>6%</u> occurred in a street, alley, or parking lot; and <u>15%</u> occurred in other locations.

In <u>33%</u> of the homicides the offender was white; and in <u>67%</u> the offender was a male. <u>60%</u> of the homicides had black victims and black offenders; <u>33%</u> had white victims and white offenders; <u>4%</u> had white victims and black offenders; and <u>0%</u> had black victims and white offenders.

Domestic Violence - Robbery

Domestic Violence - Robbery 2004

There were <u>150</u> robberies in 2004 that indicated domestic violence. This represents <u>3%</u> of the <u>5,819</u> robberies reported for Alabama in that year. <u>80</u> domestic robberies were cleared for a <u>53%</u> clearance rate. <u>33%</u> of the clearances were exceptional.

A firearm was the weapon used in $\underline{33\%}$ of the robberies; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in $\underline{49\%}$; a knife was the weapon used in $\underline{11\%}$; and other dangerous weapons were used in $\underline{7\%}$.

31% of the victims suffered injuries: 13% were injured with a firearm; 17% were injured with a knife; 48% were injured with fists, feet or hands; and 22% were injured with other dangerous weapons.

 $\underline{62\%}$ of the victims were the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender; $\underline{23\%}$ of the victims were the wife or ex-wife of the offender.

43% of the offenses occurred at a residence; 21% occurred in a street or alley; and 36% occurred in other locations.

In $\underline{71\%}$ of the robberies, the offender was black and in $\underline{87\%}$ the offender was a male.

Domestic Violence - Rape 2004

There were <u>246</u> domestic violence rapes in 2004, representing <u>15%</u> of the <u>1,665</u> rapes reported in Alabama for that year. <u>142</u> domestic rapes were cleared for a <u>58%</u> clearance rate. <u>59%</u> of the clearances were exceptional.

45% of the victims were black females and 55% were white females.

A firearm was the weapon used in $\underline{7\%}$ of the rapes; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in $\underline{84\%}$; a knife was the weapon used in $\underline{4\%}$; and other dangerous weapons were used in $\underline{5\%}$.

44% of the victims suffered injuries: 8% were injured with a firearm; 6% were injured with a knife; 84% were injured with fists, feet or hands; and 2% were injured with other dangerous weapons.

 $\underline{76\%}$ of the victims were the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender, and $\underline{24\%}$ of the victims were the wife or ex-wife of the offender.

<u>74%</u> of the offenses occurred at a residence; <u>6%</u> occurred in a street or alley; and <u>20%</u> occurred in other locations.

In 48% of the rapes the offender was white, and in 52% the offender was black.

<u>30%</u> of domestic rape victims were juveniles, but only <u>7%</u> of the offenders were juveniles.
