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Domestic Violence

This report was produced by the Statistical Analysis Center of the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center. Data presented in this report were provided by the Crime Statistics and Information Division of ACJIC for the calendar year of 2009. For purposes of this report, domestic violence is indicated when the relationship of the victim and offender is husband, wife, common-law spouse, ex-husband, ex-wife, girlfriend, boy-friend, ex-girlfriend, or ex-boyfriend. Statistics contained within this report include adult and juvenile victims.


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Domestic Violence – 2009

- Of the **20,167** violent offenses* reported in 2009, **12%** were domestic violence incidents. Domestic violence was indicated in **2,368** offenses reported: in **40** homicides; **267** rapes; **85** robberies; and in **1,976** aggravated assaults. **1,141** incidents of domestic violence were cleared for a **49%** clearance rate. **36%** of the clearances were exceptional, i.e. lack of prosecution.
- There were **29,976** domestic simple assaults, which represent **36%** of all simple assaults reported in 2009. **15,174** domestic simple assaults were cleared for a **51%** clearance rate. **41%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- 77% of the victims were females, and 23% were males. 52% of the victims were black, and 48% were white. In 58% of the offenses, the offender was black, and in 78% the offender was male.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 14% of the offenses; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in 52%; a knife was the weapon used in 14%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 20%.
- 47% of the victims suffered injuries: 9% were injured with a firearm; 19% were injured with a knife; 52% were injured with fists, hands or feet; and 20% were injured with other dangerous weapons.
- In 26% of domestic violence offenses the victim was the wife/ex-wife of the offender; in 46% the victim was the girlfriend/ex-girlfriend of the offender.



Domestic Violence - Aggravated Assault



Domestic Violence – Assault

Aggravated


- Of the **12,369** aggravated assaults reported in 2009, **1,976** were domestic aggravated assaults or **16%** of all aggravated assaults reported in Alabama for that year. **939** incidents of domestic aggravated assault were cleared for a **48%** clearance rate. **32%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 14% of the assaults; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in 49%; a knife was the weapon used in 16%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 21%.
- 50% of the victims were injured: 7% with a firearm; 21% with a knife; 50% with hands, fists or feet; and 22% with other dangerous weapons.
- 27% of the victims were a wife or ex-wife of the offender; 42% of the victims were a girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender; and 12% of the victims were a husband or ex-husband of the offender. 59% of the offenders were black, and 75% were males.

Simple

- There were **29,976** domestic simple assaults reported in 2009, or **36%** of all simple assaults for that year. **15,174** incidents of domestic simple assaults were cleared for a **52%** clearance rate. **41%** of the clearances were exceptional, i.e. lack of prosecution.
- Hands, fists, feet or voice were used as a weapon in 88% of these assaults, however, 37% of the victims still reported injuries.
- 31% of the victims were a wife or ex-wife to the offender; 49% were a girlfriend or ex-girlfriend.




Domestic Violence - Homicide

- There were 40 domestic homicides reported in 2009, representing 13% of the 318 homicides reported in Alabama for that year. 22 domestic homicides were cleared for a 67% clearance rate.
- 23% of the victims were males, and 77% were females. 53% of the victims were black, and 47% were white.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 65% of the homicides; a knife was the weapon used 20%; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in 3%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 12%.
- In 45% of the homicides the victim was the wife or ex-wife of the offender; in 10% the victim was the husband or ex-husband; in 35% the victim was the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend; and in 10% of the homicides the victim was the boyfriend or ex-boyfriend of the offender.
- 85% of the homicides occurred at a residence; 6% occurred in a parking lot; and 9% occurred in other locations.
- In 50% of the homicides the offender was black; and in 83% the offender was a male. 48% of the homicides had black victims and black offenders; 33% had white victims and white offenders; 2% had white victims and black offenders; 2% had black victims and white offenders; and in 15% of the cases the race of the offender was unknown.




Domestic Violence - Robbery

- There were **85** robberies in 2009 that indicated domestic violence. This represents **1%** of the **6,052** robberies reported for Alabama in that year. **38** domestic robberies were cleared for a **45%** clearance rate. **61%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 34% of the robberies; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in 49%; a knife was the weapon used in 5%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 12%.
- 36% of the victims suffered injuries: 35% were injured with a firearm; 0% were injured with a knife; 56% were injured with fists, feet or hands; and 9% were injured with other dangerous weapons.
- 58% of the victims were the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender; 21% of the victims were the wife or ex-wife of the offender.
- 41% of the offenses occurred at a residence; 17% occurred in a street or alley; and 42% occurred in other locations.
- In 83% of the robberies, the offender was black and in 90% the offender was a male.

Domestic Violence - Rape

- There were **267** domestic violence rapes in 2009, representing **19%** of the **1,428** rapes reported in Alabama for that year. **116** domestic rapes were cleared for a **47%** clearance rate. **55%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- 36% of the victims were black females and 62% were white females.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 5% of the rapes; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in 84%; a knife was the weapon used in 3%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 8%.
- 32% of the victims suffered injuries: 4% were injured with a firearm; 4% were injured with a knife; 84% were injured with fists, feet or hands; and 5% were injured with other dangerous weapons.
- 76% of the victims were the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender, and 24% of the victims were the wife or ex-wife of the offender.
- 84% of the offenses occurred at a residence; 1% occurred in a street or alley; and 15% occurred in other locations.
- In 51% of the rapes the offender was white, in 47% the offender was black, and in 2% the offender was of another race.
- 34% of domestic rape victims were juveniles, but only 9% of the offenders were juveniles.
