Domestic Violence

This report was produced by the Statistical Analysis Center of the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency. Data presented in this report were provided by the CJIS Administration Division of ALEA for the calendar year of 2014. For purposes of this report, domestic violence is indicated when the relationship of the victim and offender is husband, wife, common-law spouse, ex-husband, ex-wife, girlfriend, boy-friend, ex-girlfriend, or ex-boyfriend. Statistics contained within this report include adult and juvenile victims.

The Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) was created by Act 2013-67 and represents the consolidation and realignment of 12 state law enforcement agencies/functions into one entity. ALEA is responsible for the functions and missions of the Alabama Department of Homeland Security, Department of Public Safety, Alabama Bureau of Investigation, Fusion Center, Criminal Justice Information Center, Marine Police, Alcoholic Beverage Control Board Enforcement, Department of Revenue Enforcement, Forestry Commission Investigations, Agricultural and Industry Investigations, Public Service Commission Enforcement, and Office of Prosecution Service Computer Forensics Lab.

Domestic Violence – 2014


- Of the 19,628 violent offenses* reported in 2014, 17% were domestic violence incidents. Domestic violence was indicated in 3,351 offenses reported: in 24 homicides; 198 rapes; 61 robberies; and in 3,068 aggravated assaults. 1,951 incidents of domestic violence were cleared for a 58% clearance rate. 49% of the clearances were exceptional, i.e. lack of prosecution.
- There were **31,165** domestic simple assaults, which represent **38%** of all simple assaults reported in 2014. **17,825** domestic simple assaults were cleared for a **57%** clearance rate. **56%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- 80% of the victims were females, and 20% were males. 54% of the victims were black, and 46% were white. In 76% the offender was male.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 15% of the offenses; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in 50%; a knife was the weapon used in 16%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 19%.
- 84% of the offenses occurred at a residence; 7% occurred in a highway, street or alley; 3% occurred in a parking lot; 2% occurred in a hotel or motel; and 4% occurred in all other locations.
- In 20% of domestic violence offenses the victim was the wife/ex-wife of the offender; in 45% the victim was the girlfriend/ex-girlfriend of the offender.




Domestic Violence - Homicide

- There were **24** domestic homicides reported in 2014, representing **9%** of the **270** homicides reported in Alabama for that year. **15** domestic homicides were cleared for a **63%** clearance rate.
- 21% of the victims were males, and 79% were females. 46% of the victims were black and 54% were white.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 63% of the homicides; a knife was the weapon used 21%; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in 8%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 8%.
- In 49% of the homicides the victim was the wife or ex-wife of the offender; in 8% the victim was the husband or ex-husband; in 18% the victim was the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend; and in 25% of the homicides the victim was the boyfriend or ex-boyfriend of the offender.
- 75% of the homicides occurred at a residence; 21% occurred in a highway, street or alley; and 4% occurred in other locations.
- In 50% of the homicides the offender was white; and in 75% the offender was a male.




Domestic Violence - Rape*

- There were **198** domestic violence rapes in 2014, representing **11%** of the **1,890** rapes reported in Alabama for that year. **102** domestic rapes were cleared for a **52%** clearance rate. **68%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- 97% of the victims were females and 3% were males. 70% of the victims were white and 30% were black.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 4% of the rapes; hands, fists, or feet were used as a weapon in 83%; a knife was the weapon used in 3%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 10%.
- 43% of the victims suffered additional injuries.
- 55% of the victims were the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender, and 21% of the victims were the wife or ex-wife of the offender.
- 84% of the offenses occurred at a residence; 2% occurred in a street or alley; 3% occurred in a hotel or motel, and 11% occurred in other locations.
- In 60% of the rapes the offender was white; in 35% the offender was black; and in 5% of the rapes the race of the offender was unknown.
- 32% of domestic rape victims were juveniles.


^{*}Prior to 2013, Rape included only <u>female</u> victims. In 2013 the definition of rape was expanded by the FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting Program to include male victims and other types of sexual assault offenses. Because of this change, the number of reported rapes increased in 2014 compared to 2012.

Domestic Violence - Robbery

- There were **61** robberies in 2014 that indicated domestic violence. This represents **1%** of the **4,481** robberies reported for Alabama in that year. **33** domestic robberies were cleared for a **54%** clearance rate. **67%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 13% of the robberies; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in 64%; a knife was the weapon used in 5%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 18%.
- 48% of the victims suffered injuries.
- 56% of the victims were the girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender; 5% of the victims were the wife or ex-wife of the offender; and 39% were the boyfriend or ex-boyfriend of the offender.
- 61% of the offenses occurred at a residence; 13% occurred in a street or alley; 13% occurred in a parking lot; and 13% occurred in other locations.
- In 71% of the robberies, the offender was black and in 84% the offender was a male.

Domestic Violence – Assault

Aggravated

- Of the **12,987** aggravated assaults reported in 2014, **3,068** were domestic aggravated assaults or **24%** of all aggravated assaults reported in Alabama for that year. **1,801** incidents of domestic aggravated assault were cleared for a **59%** clearance rate. **48%** of the clearances were exceptional.
- A firearm was the weapon used in 16% of the assaults; hands, fists or feet were used as a weapon in 52%; a knife was the weapon used in 16%; and other dangerous weapons were used in 16%.
- 59% of the victims were injured.
- 20% of the victims were a wife or ex-wife of the offender; 45% of the victims were a girlfriend or ex-girlfriend of the offender; 11% of the victims were a husband or ex-husband of the offender; and 24% were the boyfriend or ex-boyfriend of the offender. 57% of the offenders were black, and 75% were males.


Simple

- There were **31,165** domestic simple assaults reported in 2014, or **38%** of all simple assaults for that year. **17,825** incidents of domestic simple assaults were cleared for a **57%** clearance rate. **56%** of the clearances were exceptional, i.e. lack of prosecution.
- Hands, fists, feet or voice were used as a weapon in 87% of these assaults; however, 40% of the victims still reported injuries.
- 25% of the victims were a wife or ex-wife to the offender; 43% were a girlfriend or ex-girlfriend.
